Alameda Watershed HCP Meeting December 8 in Dublin

The San Francisco Public Utilities Commission will hold a public meeting in Dublin this Thursday, December 8, from 6:30 to 8 pm, regarding their proposed Alameda Watershed Habitat Conservation Plan (HCP).

The Habitat Conservation Plan will cover SFPUC projects, maintenance, and operations in the upper Alameda Creek Watershed. The HCP will be a long-term conservation plan for land use and biological planning on SFPUC lands. The HCP will result in a federal permit allowing the SFPUC to legally "take" or harm endangered species, in exchange for conservation measures intended to protect the species and their habitats.

Thursday's meeting will be an informational open house followed by a question and answer session to provide an update on the status of the HCP, specifically sections on the Impact Analysis and Conservation Strategy, and an overview of fish issues in the HCP.

The meeting will be held at the Dublin Public Library Community Room, 200 Civic Plaza, in Dublin. See the ACA web page or the SFPUC web page on the HCP for background information.

Last year 83 birders tallied <u>150</u> <u>bird species</u> during the count; our fledgling count was 94th nationally in terms of number of species seen!
