Judge Issues Temporary Restraining Order Halting Caltrans Highway Widening In Niles

Yesterday an Alameda Superior Court Judge granted the Alameda Creek Alliance's request for a Temporary Restraining Order barring Caltrans from initiating planned construction June 15 on the first phase of the controversial \$80 million highway widening project in Niles Canyon along Alameda Creek. The restraining order is in effect until a June 23 hearing on whether the Alameda Creek Alliance may proceed to trial challenging the inadequate environmental review for the Route 84 "Safety Improvement" project.

Come to the June 23 Court Hearing in Oakland

Thursday, June 23, the Alameda Superior Court will hold a hearing on whether to grant the Alameda Creek Alliance an injunction against Caltrans from continuing with construction on the phase one Niles Canyon project, and whether we can proceed to trial to determine the legality and adequacy of the shoddy environmental review for the project.

The hearing will be at 11:00 am in Department 31 of the County of Alameda Superior Court, located at 201 - 13th Street, in Oakland. Department 31 is located on the second floor of the U.S. Post Office Building.

If you are interested in attending, it would help to have a showing of community interest in the case for the judge. Please be respectful and quiet in the courtroom regardless of the court's decision.

San Francisco Explains Role in Land Swap for Tree Cutting

Read the SFPUC's <u>June 9 letter</u> explaining how San Francisco transferred land title and gave legal easements in Niles Canyon to Caltrans for construction of phase one of the Niles highway project, the areas where trees have been cut and further impacts to the creek are planned. The SFPUC has committed to requiring Caltrans to "minimize and mitigate any and all potential environmental impacts to Alameda Creek" before considering another real estate transaction for phase two.
