Conservation Agreement Will Protect East Bay Burrowing Owl Habitat

The Alameda Creek Alliance signed a conservation agreement with the City of Dublin and Dublin Crossing Venture that will protect 313 acres of habitat in the East Bay for the declining western burrowing owl population. The agreement resolves a lawsuit filed over the Dublin Crossing Project, a 189-acre residential and commercial development on land just north of the East Dublin BART station.
