

Submit comments on the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission's Habitat Conservation Plan (HCP) for the upper Alameda Creek Watershed. The HCP will cover the impacts of SFPUC projects, maintenance, and operations on 17 native species.

Talking Points:

- *The HCP should contain meaningful mitigation measures that further the recovery of the covered species*
- *The HCP should mitigate for ecosystem impacts of all three SFPUC dams in the watershed*
 - *Remove the Alameda Diversion Dam*
 - *Restore more natural stream flow in Alameda Creek below the dams*
 - *Provide for fish passage at SFPUC dams or mitigate for blocked habitat*
 - *Release water flows adequate for steelhead*
 - *Enhance habitat for native fish and other aquatic wildlife below dams*
- *Properly manage cattle grazing in the watershed*
 - *Fence cattle out of riparian zone and all trout spawning areas*
 - *Monitor grassland health and water quality*
 - *Address lack of oak tree recruitment*
- *Provide scientific peer review of all reports and documents for the HCP*
