

## Become an Alameda Creek StreamKeeper

**Help the Alameda Creek Alliance keep an eye on the creek and monitor fish populations and habitat by signing up as a volunteer StreamKeeper.**

StreamKeepers adopt a section of the creek to monitor for migratory fish during the winter and to monitor year-round for water quality, pollutants, dumping, poaching, or habitat destruction.

We particularly need volunteers for the following stream sections:

- Lower flood control channel - between Hwy 880 and DeCoto Road crossing
- Middle flood control channel - between DeCoto Road crossing and the lower rubber dam
- Lower rubber dam
- BART weir
- Stonybrook Creek
- Lower Niles Canyon – up to Stonybrook Creek
- Middle Niles Canyon - from Stonybrook Creek to gravel turnout
- Upper Niles Canyon to Niles Dam
- Confluence of Alameda Creek and Arroyo de la Laguna
- Lower Sunol Valley - Alameda Creek near Sunol Golf Course and Water Temple
- Middle Sunol Valley - Alameda Creek near gravel quarries
- Upper Sunol Valley - Alameda Creek near Sunol Valley Water Treatment Plant
