April 1 – **Salmon Summit** - San Francisco

Sport and commercial salmon fishers and salmon advocates will hold a salmon summit tomorrow, April 1, from 10 am to 2 pm at the Fort Mason Conference Center in San Francisco, demanding action to rebuild the west coast's iconic salmon industry dependent on the Sacramento Bay-Delta.

There will be hearing about the devastating costs of cancelling the last two salmon fishing seasons on families along 1,000 miles of America's coast, testimony by Congressmen George Miller (Concord), Mike Thompson (Napa) and other state and federal officials, and a forum to discuss long-term solutions to better manage the Sacramento River and Bay-Delta, the backbone of fishing for Chinook salmon in California and Oregon.

The event will include a free seafood reception hosted by Scoma's, Hayes Street Grill, Fish, Foreign Cinema, and Monterey Fish Market.
