PROVIDES INFORMATION - The Master Plan is a source of information to the community about parks, facilities and recreation services as well as the benefits of these services.

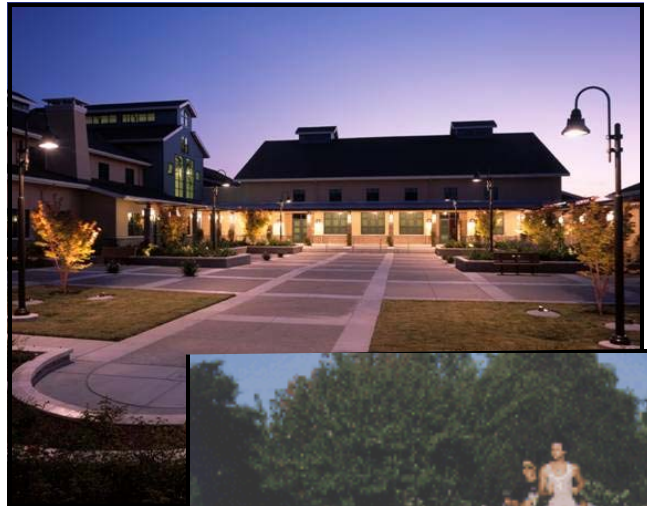
IDENTIFIES FUNDING - The Plan establishes priorities for funding and identifies potential funding sources for future improvements and programs.
