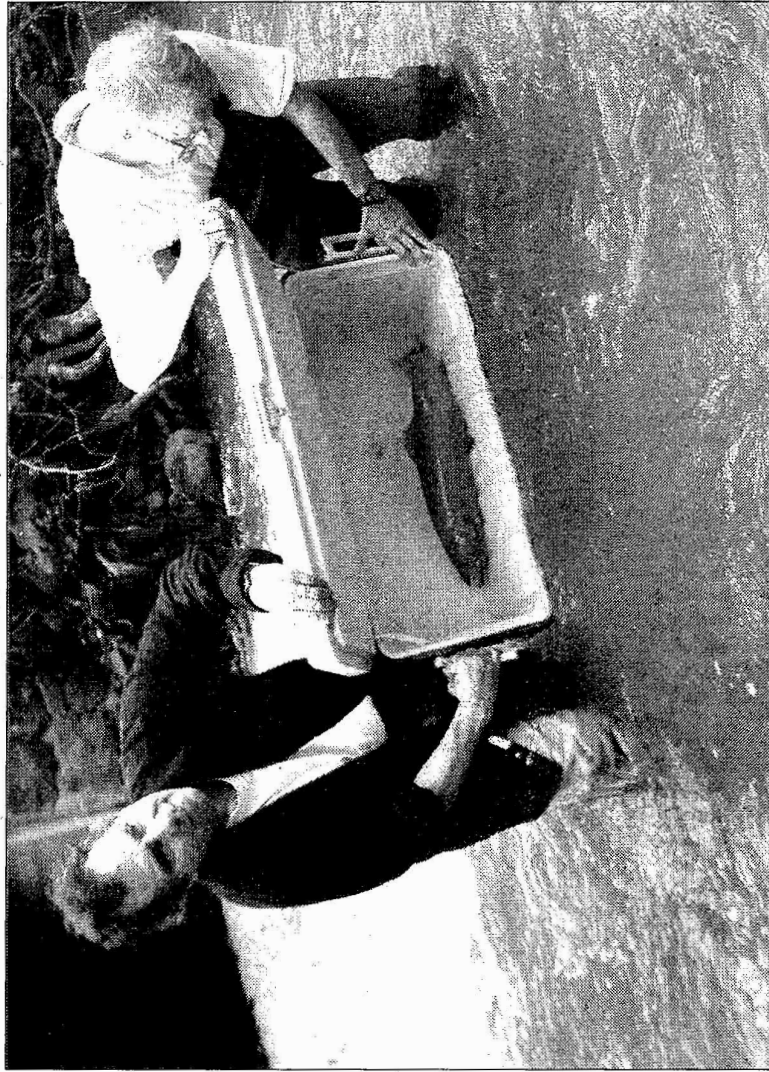
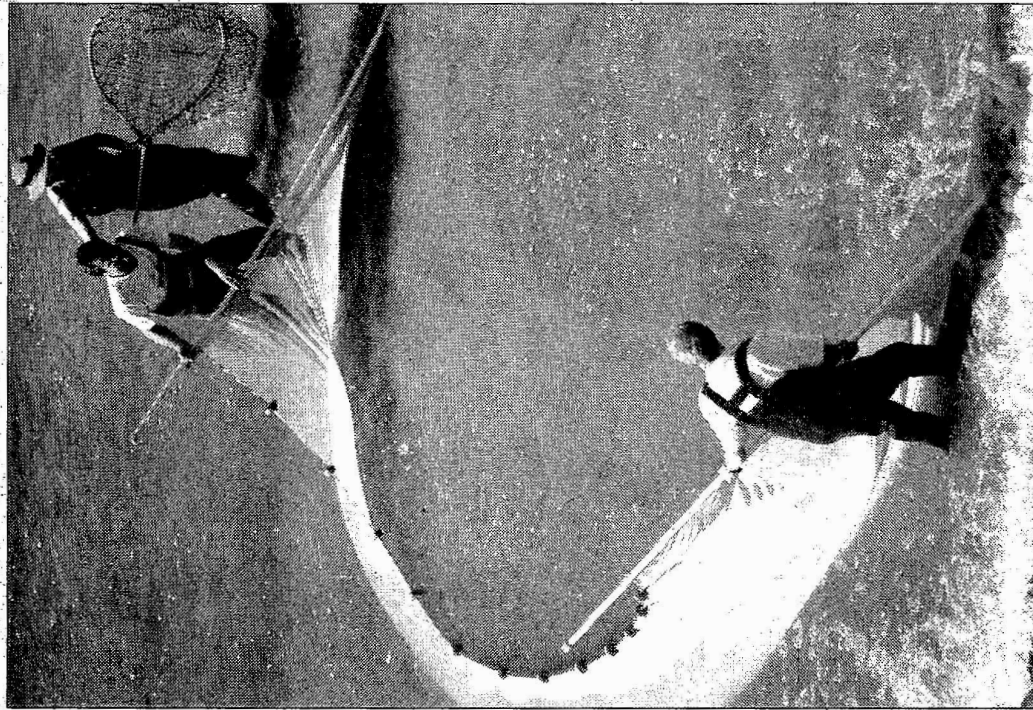


SPAWN-TANEIOUS ACT OF KINDNESS
